These trips will be announced in advance. There are no limitations or restrictions of any kind whatsoever on such participation unless this line is checked _____ with an explanation attached.
2. The Minor has been instructed by me and understands and agrees to comply with all rules, regulations and Code of Conduct established by Sinai Temple and the Sinai Temple Religious School and the official instructions and directives of all authorized staff members, volunteers, agents and employees ("Personnel") of Sinai Temple.
3. You are expressly authorized to engage appropriate health care providers to administer, prescribe and/or direct the administration of any medication, other medical treatment, care, surgery, hospitalization or medical procedures and services deemed appropriate under the circumstances. If you are not able to contact me for timely instructions, you are authorized to act as my authorized agent and at my sole cost and expense. There are no exceptions or limitations or other special instructions in connection with the foregoing unless this line is checked _____ with an explanation attached to this page. This authorization is given pursuant to the provisions of Section 25.8 of the Civil Code of California.
4. Unless this line is checked _____ and I have provided you with specific instructions, directions or other specific data to the contrary on the reverse side of this or an attached page, you may assume the Minor has no medical disabilities, allergies or other limitations of any kind whatsoever that might in any way limit participation in the scheduled activities.
5. I expressly release and agree to indemnify and hold Sinai Temple and the Sinai Temple Religious School (and its personnel) free and harmless from any liability, charges, claims, costs and expenses of every kind and nature whatsoever, including reasonable attorney fees, in connection with the acceptance and participation of the Minor in the Scheduled Activity. The foregoing Release is without reservation of any kind except only for such acts or omissions on your part that arise out of your intentional or negligent wrongdoing and without fault of any kind on the part of the Minor or on my part in failing to disclose pertinent information to you.
6. CONSENT AGREEMENT:
For consideration and for the promotional use of Sinai Temple Religious School, the undersigned, as parent or legal guardian of the child named above, irrevocably consents to the use by Sinai Temple of the child's photograph, name, and likeness in brochures, DVDs or any other promotional materials for the Religious School, and grants Sinai Temple all rights to use such photograph, name and likeness in such promotional materials.
7. I represent to you that I have sole, full and legal power and the right to execute this Consent, and that you will rely on my representations.
8. If this Consent is signed by more than one person, all references of the singular include the plural, jointly and severally.

SCHOOL CONTRACT

Sinai Temple Religious School has always promoted the importance of Derech Eretz (respectful conduct). As a student and parent of the school we each commit ourselves:

- 1. To act with respect toward fellow students, parents, teachers, teacher’s assistants, administrators and employees and members of Sinai Temple.
2. To refrain from conduct which would disrupt the orderly functioning of the school or temple or which would tend to bring discredit on the school or temple, its students, parents, teachers, teacher’s assistants or administrators.
3. To act with good manners, be tolerant of each other’s differences and not engage in unseemly criticism, name calling or “put downs”.
4. To act with respect and care of textbooks and materials, the property of others, including Sinai Temple and school buildings, furniture and equipment.
5. To observe the school’s religious policies (e.g. kippot, kashruth, Shabbat dress).
6. To be on time and to dress properly for school and school-related functions.
7. To obey all the rules, policies and procedures established for the orderly functioning of the school, by the school, its administrators, teachers or by Sinai Temple.
8. To act with concern for the safety of all associated with the school and Sinai Temple in accordance with the rules and policies of the school of Sinai Temple (e.g. at play, in the Sinai Temple garages and in delivering and picking up children at the school or at a school-related function).

In addition, THE FOLLOWING ARE REQUIRED FOR CHILDREN ATTENDING TWO DAYS PER WEEK:

Students attending two days/week are required to attend 7 ST✡RS Shabbat services per year.

Homework is often required of all students. In addition, students are expected to practice Hebrew reading at home on a regular basis.

If a student in 3rd-7th grade misses more than 12 classes, does not complete the required attendance of seven times per year to ST✡RS Shabbat, and does not complete the required make-up work or services, he/she will not be promoted to the next grade and there will be possible postponement of Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

If school is missed for any reason, the student is responsible for completing the missed assignments on his/her own time. If the student has missed multiple days of school, he/she may be required to make up missed classes at the discretion of the Religious School Director.

We each understand and agree that compliance with the terms of this Contract is a condition to both the admission and continued attendance of the undersigned student(s) in the school.
